HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT OF CPE AT CARLE FOUNDATION HOSPITAL: Carle is a teaching, research hospital and has been since its founding in 1931. Charles VanVorst became President of the hospital in 1979. Previously, he was in administration at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis and was familiar with the Pastoral Care Department and CPE. He envisioned a Pastoral Care Department and education program as a means to round out the holistic care of patients and broaden the teaching components of the hospital. By 1981 Dr. R. Paul Walters was supervising the first program under the status of candidacy.

PROGRAM FUNDING – PRESENT, PAST, SOURCES: The program is funded through the operating budget of the hospital.
