HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT OF CPE AT HEALTH SYSTEM MINNESOTA-METHODIST HOSPITAL: In 1966 Clinical Pastoral Education had its formal beginning at Methodist Hospital. Chaplain Donald Woodward, accredited by the Institute of Pastoral Care, conducted one quarter of CPE in which six students participated. This first program was financed by the hospital through action taken by the Board of Governors.

PROGRAM FUNDING – PRESENT, PAST, SOURCES: The program presently is funded primarily through grant support awarded through The Foundation, HealthSystem Minnesota, for five residencies and one Supervisory residency. Supervision currently is provided by the Manager of Spiritual Care, funded entirely by Methodist Hospital, HealthSystem Minnesota.
