The Professional Ethics Commission met for three and a half days in Dallas, April 22-25, 2004. One half day was spent giving feedback to the re-writing Committee. Standards and all manuals of the Commissions are due for a re-write to become effective, 2005. This will keep our organization in compliance with the Department of Education for Medicare Pass through funds. Please give your feedback to the Standards Committee or to the Ethics Chair when you receive the documents.

Again Ethics Education is recommended for every unit of CPE taught. This is especially highly recommended for those doing Supervisory Education.

The Commission removed the Probationary status of one ACPE Member.

The Commission also sanctioned another Member on the level of Reprimand.
